### **Limitations and Exclusions**

- Persons with a history of heart disease, heart attack or stroke prior to the coverage effective date or within 30 days thereafter will not be covered.
- This policy only covers loss due to heart disease, heart attack or stroke. The First Occurrence benefit is not paid for heart disease.
- Benefits are not payable for any day of hospitalization unless the day of hospitalization is the direct result of heart disease, heart attack or stroke.
- Benefits paid for any one person will not exceed the maximum benefits shown in the Benefit Schedule regardless of the number or types of heart disease, heart attacks or strokes.
